### SEGURA VIUDAS NV BRUT RESERVA

Spain (\$9)  
Our top choice, this reserve bubbly is full-bodied and rich-tasting, yet still crisp and clean. Like all Spanish cavas, it's aged in the bottle for maximum flavor



### PAUL CHENEAU "LADY OF SPAIN" CAVA

Spain (\$15)  
We picked it up for the distinctive label but fell in love with its toasty, nutty blend of three Spanish grape varietals from the Penedès region



### GRUET BRUT NV

New Mexico (\$14)  
Crafted in a family-owned winery using the traditional French Champagne method, this New Mexico-made sparkler is dry and refreshing, with a hint of citrus and green apple
