For a less expensive option that can taste just as good, consider cava, a Spanish style of sparkling wine that's made in the same way as Champagne, but uses a different kind of grape. A bottle of cava can run as low as \$10 (the bottle pictured here is [Segura Viudas Reserva Heredad](#) and costs \$20), so you don't have to bust your budget pouring every guest a glass.
